1858 CHAPTER 49

II As to the Form of Oath in other Cases.

In all other Cases, except for sitting in Parliament as aforesaid, or in qualifying to exercise the Right of Presentation to any Ecclesiastical Benefice in *Scotland*, whenever any of Her Majesty's Subjects professing the Jewish Religion shall be required to take the said Oath, the Words " and I make this Declaration upon the true Faith of a Christian " shall be omitted.
