

Confirmation of Executors (Scotland) Act 1858

1858 CHAPTER 56 21 and 22 Vict

8 Where inventories, &c. may be recorded. Confirmations may be granted.

Inventories of ^{F1} estates of deceased persons and relative testamentary writings may be given up and recorded in, and confirmations may be granted and issued by, any commissary court to which it is competent to apply in virtue of the provisions of this Act for the appointment of an executor dative to the deceased.
