CHAPTER 57

ECCLESIASTICAL LEASING ACT 1858 (REPEALED)

Leases under 5 & 6 Vict. c. 108. may be granted in consideration of premiums; and, sales or exchanges of lands may be effected in certain Application monies produced by sales, &c. Power to raise money to be paid for equality of exchange or partition. Power to enter into and vary contracts and accept surrenders. Provision for payment of expenses of leases. This Act not to repeal powers under former Acts, 1843 c. 37 &c. 8 On sale or purchase of part of estate held under a lease the rent to be apportioned. No lease to be granted of land acquired under the Act, except at rackrent. 10 11 12 Other clauses not hereby repealed incorporated in this Act. 13

Act to extend only to England and Wales, Isle of Man, &c.
