2 New charters may be granted to the colleges.

Any new charter which, under the provisions of the Medical Act, shall be granted to the corporation of the Royal College of Physicians of London, may be granted to them either by and in the name of the Royal College of Physicians of London, or, as provided by that Act, by and in the name of the Royal College of Physicians of England; . . . ^{F1}
