1860 CHAPTER 66

II New Charters may be granted to the Colleges.

Any new Charter which, under the Provisions of the Medical Act, shall be granted to the Corporation of the Royal College of Physicians of *London*, may be granted to them either by and in the Name of the Royal College of Physicians of *London*, or, as provided by that Act, by and in the Name of the Royal College of Physicians of *England*; and any such new Charter granted to the Corporation of the Royal College of Physicians of *Edinburgh* may be granted to that College either by and in its present Name, or, as provided by the Medical Act, by and in the Name of the Royal College of Physicians of *Scotland*; and any such new Charter granted to the Corporation of the King and Queen's College of Physicians in *Ireland* may be granted to that College either by and in its present Name, or, as provided by the Medical Act, by and in the Name of the Royal College of Physicians of *Ireland*.
