



Conjugal Rights (Scotland) Amendment Act 1861

1861 CHAPTER 86

19 Interpretation of Terms.

The following Words and Expressions, when used in this Act, shall, in the Construction thereof, be interpreted as follows, except where the Nature of the Provision or the Context of the Act shall exclude or be repugnant to such Construction; that is to say, the Expression " Lord Ordinary " shall include his Successor; the Word " Property" shall include and apply to all Property falling under the Jus mariti; the Expression " Consistorial Action" shall include Actions of Declarator of Marriage, of Declarator of Nullity of Marriage, of Declarator of Legitimacy and Bastardy, Actions of Separation *a mensâ et thoro*, of Divorce and of Adherence, and of putting to Silence, and Actions of Aliment between Husband and Wife instituted in the Court of Session.
