1862 CHAPTER 53

PART I

AS TO THE REGISTRATION OF REAL ESTATES, AND THE TITLE THERETO

Proceedings to obtain Registration of a Title as indefeasible

13 Cause may be shown against Registration.

At the Time and Place named in the Notice, or at such Time and Place as General Orders shall direct, any Person may attend and show Cause before the Registrar, by Affidavit or otherwise, against the Registration, or claim that the same should be subject to any Conditions or Reservations; the Registrar may decide on such Objection or Claim, or may refer the same to the Judge of the Court of Chancery: If the Registrar decide, either Party may appeal from his Decision to the said Court, in manner hereinafter directed.
