1863 CHAPTER 47 26 and 27 Vict

3 Provision in case of a minister being suspended.

When, by their final sentence upon a libel, a Presbytery or other church court shall suspend a minister from the discharge of the duties of his office for a term specified in the said sentence, it is hereby further declared and enacted, that it is and shall be held to be the right of the Presbytery to appoint a qualified assistant to discharge the said duties^{F1}
