



Clerical Subscription Act 1865

1865 CHAPTER 122 28 and 29 Vict

9 No other declaration or oaths than those required by Act to be enforced.

Subject as herein-after mentioned, no person shall, on or as a consequence of ordination, or on or as a consequence of being licensed to any stipendiary curacy, or on or as a consequence of being presented, instituted, collated, elected, or licensed to any benefice with cure of souls, perpetual curacy, lectureship, or preachership, be required to make any subscription or declaration, or take any oath, other than such subscriptions, declarations, and oath as are required by this Act [^{F1}or by Canon of the General Synod].
