1865 CHAPTER 125 28 and 29 Vict

4 Appointment of Queen's harbour masters.

[F1The Secretary of State] may from time to time appoint for each dockyard port a fit person to superintend the execution of this Act, and otherwise to protect the port, to be called the Queen's harbour master for the respective port.
