

Metropolitan Fire Brigade Act 1865

1865 CHAPTER 90 28 and 29 Vict

Expenses

24 Recovery of penalties.

All penalties imposed by this Act, or by any byelaw made in pursuance thereof, and all expenses and other sums due to the [FIGreater London Council] in pursuance of this Act, in respect of which no mode of recovery is prescribed, may be recovered summarily before two justices in manner directed by the [F2MI] Magistrates' Courts Act 1952], or any Act amending the same, and when so recovered shall be paid to the treasurer of the [FIGreater London Council], notwithstanding any Police Act or other Act of Parliament directing a different appropriation of such monies.
