

Exchequer and Audit Departments Act 1866

1866 CHAPTER 39 29 and 30 Vict

19 Treasury may direct consolidation of accounts at the Bank.

It shall be lawful for the Treasury, whenever they shall consider it for the advantage of the public service, to direct that the accounts of any public officer or department, which by any Act or Acts are required to be kept under separate heads at the Bank of England ^{FI}..., shall be consolidated in such manner as they shall judge most convenient for the public service.
