CHAPTER 24

CAPITAL PUNISHMENT AMENDMENT ACT 1868 (REPEALED)

Short title. Executions to be within prison. Sheriff, &c., to be present. Justices may be present, and other persons may be admitted. Certificate of death. Coroner's inquest on body. Burial of body, within walls of prison, or, in certain cases, elsewhere. Power to Secretary of State to make rules. Such rules to be laid before Parliament. 10 Publication of certificate and inquisition. Execution of duties and powers of sheriff, gaoler, &c. by under-sheriff, deputy gaoler, &c. Forms in schedule to be used. 12 13 Application to Scotland. 14 15 Saving. Sentence to be carried out as heretofore.
