



Entail Amendment (Scotland) Act 1868

1868 CHAPTER 84 31 and 32 Vict

12 Provisions of Act 10 G. 3. c. 51. to apply to dwellings for the labouring classes.

It shall be sufficient compliance with the provisions of the said Act and of the ^{M1}Entail Improvement Act, 1770, the Entail Amendment Act, 1848, and the Entail Amendment Act, 1853, therein recited, if it be shown that the cottages in respect of which a charge is proposed to be created, or towards the erection of which monies are sought to be applied, have been completed in a proper and substantial manner, and it shall not be necessary to prove that they are required for the accommodation of the labourers, farm servants, artisans, and others employed on or connected with the entailed estate on which they have been or may be erected.
