1869 CHAPTER 107 32 and 33 Vict

3 Extension of right to memorialize.

A scheme may be made, under the ^{M1}Metropolitan Commons Act 1866, on a memorial in that behalf presented to the Commissioners by any twelve or more ratepayers, inhabitants of the parish or parishes in which the metropolitan common is situate, as well as by any such person, persons, or body as is or are described in section six of the said Act.
