#### [<sup>F1</sup>56 Recovery of tolls, penalties, &c.]

All tolls, penalties, and charges under this Act, or under any byelaw made in pursuance of this Act, may be recovered and enforced as follows; in England before two justices of the peace in manner directed by the Summary Jurisdiction (England) Acts, and in Scotland before the sheriff or two justices as penalties under the <sup>M1</sup>Railways Clauses Consolidation (Scotland) Act 1845.]
