Legal Procedure

25 Power of Secretary of State or executive authority to grant search warrant.

The Secretary of State [Flor the chief executive authority] may, by warrant, empower any person to enter any dockyard or other place within Her Majesty's dominions and inquire as to the destination of any ship which may appear to him to be intended to be employed in the naval or military service of any foreign state at war with a friendly state, and to search such ship.
