



Clerical Disabilities Act 1870

1870 CHAPTER 91 33 and 34 Vict

7 Copy of record to be evidence.

A copy of the record in the registry of a diocese of a deed of relinquishment, under this Act, duly extracted and certified by the registrar of the bishop, shall be evidence of the due execution, inrolment, and recording of the deed, and of the fulfilment of all the requirements of this Act in relation thereto.

The registrar of the bishop shall, on the application of the person executing the deed, give to him a copy of the record thereof duly extracted and certified, on payment of a fee not exceeding [^{F1}50p] for the recording and copy thereof.
