1871 CHAPTER 96 34 and 35 Vict

Certificates to be obtained by Pedlars

10 Certificate not to be assigned.

A person to whom a pedlar's certificate is granted under this Act shall not lend, transfer, or assign the same to any other person, and any person who lends, transfers, or assigns such certificate to any other person shall for each offence be liable to a penalty not exceeding [^{F1}level 1 on the standard scale].
