

Works and Public Buildings Act 1874

1874 CHAPTER 84 37 and 38 Vict

2 Commissioners incorporated by 14 & 15 Vict. c. 42 to have the powers conferred on subsequent Commissioners.

The Commissioners of Works as incorporated by and for the purposes of the Crown Lands Act 1851, are hereby declared to be, and shall be a Corporation to all intents and purposes, and as such shall have and hold, and may exercise not only all the estates, property, interests, privileges, and powers now vested in or enjoyed by them under that Act, but also all estates, property, interests, privileges, and powers now vested in or held or enjoyed by the Commissioners of Works as a Corporation under the MICommissioners of Works Act 1852 or any subsequent Act, and in or by the Battersea Park Commissioners.
