SCHOOLS SITES ACT 1841

- 2 Landlords empowered to convey land to be used as sites for schools,
&c.
- 3 Chancellor and council of the duchy of Lancaster empowered to grant
lands to the trustees of any existing or intended school.
- 4
- 5 Persons under disability empowered to convey lands for the purposes of
this Act.
- 6 Corporations, justices, trustees, &c. empowered to convey lands for the
purposes of this Act.
- 7 Grants of land may be made to corporations or trustees, to be held by
them for school purposes.
- 8 Estates now vested in trustees for the purposes of education may be
conveyed to the minister and churchwardens.
- 9 Any number of sites may be granted for separate schools.
- 10 Form of grants, &c.
- 11 Application of purchase money for land sold by any ecclesiastical
corporation sole.

- 13 Ecclesiastical corporations sole to procure a certificate as to the extent
of the land conveyed.
- 14 Trustees empowered to sell or exchange lands or buildings.

- 17 No schoolmaster to acquire a life interest by virtue of his appointment.
