### 66 Prison Commissioners to discharge duties of department of judicial statistics. U.K.

The Prison Commissioners shall be the department of judicial statistics under the <sup>M1</sup>Judicial Statistics (Scotland) Act 1869, and shall discharge the duties of the said department, and all statutory returns relating to such statistics shall be made to them accordingly . . . <sup>F2</sup>
