1878 CHAPTER 71 41 and 42 Vict

2 Power to Metropolitan Board to acquire and hold common rights.

[^{F1}A London borough shall, in respect of any common the whole or part of which is situate within the borough,] have the same power to purchase and hold, with a view to prevent the extinction of the rights of common, any saleable rights in common, or any tenement of a commoner having annexed thereto rights of common, as is conferred by the fifth paragraph of the eighth section of the ^{M1}Commons Act 1876 upon [^{F2}a district council] in respect of a suburban common.
