

Judicial Factors (Scotland) Act 1880

1880 CHAPTER 4 43 and 44 Vict

6 Fees payable by estates deriving benefit from Act.

There shall be payable . . . ^{FI} by each estate under charge of a Judicial Factor appointed under this Act, such fees as shall from time to time be authorised by the Court of Session, having due regard to the sums required for the purposes of this Act, and to the interests of the estates to be benefited thereby; and . . . ^{FI} it shall be lawful for the Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury to make such additions as they shall think fit to the salaries of the accountant and clerks appointed and acting under the recited Act, and to grant such salary or salaries as shall seem proper to any other clerk or clerks whom the said Commissioners shall think fit to appoint for the purposes of this Act.
