1882 CHAPTER 77

An Act to amend the Law of Citation in Scotland.

[18th August 1882]

WHEREAS by the Citation Amendment (Scotland) Act, the process of citation in Scotland was amended in certain particulars, and it is desirable that it should be further amended :

Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:
