1883 CHAPTER 18

4 Saving for new charters and for charities

Nothing in this Act shall prevent the application to any place of any charter applying the Municipal Corporation Acts which Her Majesty may be pleased to grant, or affect anything done in pursuance of those Acts or any scheme thereunder, and shall not affect the operation of any such charter, thing, or scheme; save that nothing in the said Acts or scheme shall authorise the establishment or continuance of any court for the trial of civil actions.

- (2) Nothing in this Act shall affect the right to the benefit of any charity, or shall alter or confer any power of altering the denned charitable purposes (if any) to which any property is by law applicable at the passing of this Act.
