



# Metropolitan Police Act 1886

1886 CHAPTER 22 49 and 50 Vict

[<sup>F1</sup>6 **Approval of Secretary of State for purchases and loans.**

Every purchase, sale, scheme, or lease by the police receiver under the Metropolitan Police Acts, 1829 to 1884, or this Act . . . <sup>F2</sup> shall be subject to the approval of a Secretary of State. . . . <sup>F2</sup> provided that it shall not be necessary for any vendor, purchaser, lessor, lessee, or lender to ascertain that such approval has been given.]
