

Metropolitan Police Act 1886

1886 CHAPTER 22 49 and 50 Vict

[F16 Approval of Secretary of State for purchases and loans.

Every purchase, sale, scheme, or lease by the police receiver under the Metropolitan Police Acts, 1829 to 1884, or this Act . . . ^{F2} shall be subject to the approval of a Secretary of State. . . . ^{F2} provided that it shall not be necessary for any vendor, purchaser, lessor, lessee, or lender to ascertain that such approval has been given.]
