9 Definitions.

In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires—

The expression “person” includes a body of persons, corporate or unincorporate:

The expression “police district”^{F1} and the expression “police fund” have the same meaning as in the ^{M1}Police Act 1964 and the expression “compensation authority” means—
