## *Allowance for Spoiled Stamps*

### 11 Allowance how to be made. **U.K.**

In any case in which allowance is made for spoiled or misused stamps the Commissioners may give in lieu thereof other stamps of the same denomination and value, or if required, and they think proper, stamps of any other denomination to the same amount in value, or in their discretion, the same value in money,<sup>F1</sup> . . .
