PART I

PROVISION OF SMALL HOLDINGS BY COUNTY COUNCILS

Power to the limited owner to sell at a fee farm rent

A person having the powers of a tenant for life within the meaning of the Settled Land Act, 1882, may grant the settled land or a partthereof, to a county council for the purposes of this Act inperpetuity, at a fee farm or other rent secured by condition of reentry, or otherwise as may be agreed upon.
