CHAPTER 4

BETTING AND LOANS (INFANTS) ACT 1892 (REPEALED 25.9.1991)

- 1 Persons sending documents to an infant inciting to betting guilty of a misdemeanour.
- 2 Persons sending to infants circulars inviting to borrow money guilty of a misdemeanour.
- 3 Knowledge of infancy presumed in certain cases.
- 4 Soliciting infant to make affidavit in connexion with loan.
- 5 Avoiding contract for payment of loan advanced during infancy.
- 6 Person charged a competent witness.
- 7 Application to Scotland.
- 8 Short title.
