

# Metropolitan Police (Receiver) Act 1895

## 1895 CHAPTER 12 58 and 59 Vict

## U.K.

An Act to make provision for the temporary absence of the Receiver for the Metropolitan Police District. [14th May 1895]

#### **1** Power to provide for temporary absence of receiver. U.K.

If and whilst the receiver for the metropolitan police district is temporarily [<sup>F2</sup>unable to act whether by reason of absence or otherwise] a person appointed by warrant under the hand of the Secretary of State may temporarily act as and shall be deemed for all purposes to be such receiver.

### 2 Short title. U.K.

This Act may be cited as the Metropolitan Police (Receiver) Act 1895, and shall be read with the Metropolitan Police Acts 1829 to 1890.
