1843 CHAPTER 86 6 and 7 Vict

2 Interpretation of terms.

^{F1} . . . the word “proprietor” shall include every person who, either alone or in partnership with any other person, shall keep any hackney carriage ^{F2} . . . , or who shall be concerned otherwise than as a driver or attendant in employing for hire any hackney carriage ^{F1}
