# 141 Power of borrowing for hospitals, &c.

It shall be lawful for the local authority to borrow for the purpose of providing offices for the use of the local authority, and for providing and furnishing such . . .  $^{F3}$  disinfecting premises and apparatus, houses of reception, or mortuaries as are hereinbefore authorised . . .  $^{F4}$  such sums of money and at such times as they shall deem necessary for that purpose . . .  $^{F4}$
