1898 CHAPTER 36 61 and 62 Vict

6 Provisions as to previous Acts.

- (1) This Act shall apply to all criminal proceedings [^{F1}including proceedings in courts-martial]^{F2} under the ^{M1}Army Act 1955 and the ^{M2}Air Force Act 1955, and proceedings in courts-martial ^{F3} . . . under the ^{M3}Naval Discipline Act 1957]^{F4} and in Standing Civilian Courts established under the ^{M4}Armed Forces Act 1976], [^{F5}notwithstanding any enactment in force at the commencement of this Act,] . . . ^{F6}
