



# Criminal Evidence Act 1898

1898 CHAPTER 36 61 and 62 Vict

## 6 Provisions as to previous Acts.

(1) This Act shall apply to all criminal proceedings<sup>F1</sup> . . .

[<sup>F2</sup>(1A) This Act applies in relation to service proceedings as it applies in relation to criminal proceedings before a court in England and Wales.

(1B) In this section “service proceedings” means proceedings before a court (other than a civilian court) in respect of a service offence; and “service offence” and “civilian court” here have the same meanings as in the Armed Forces Act 2006.]
