SCHOOL SITES ACT 1844

[1.]	The terms and conditions upon which parliamentary aid has been given
	towards the building of schools secured upon the site.
2	The terms upon which aid shall be granted to Trustees of ancient endowed schools.

4	Site may be granted to the minister and churchwardens.
5	Rector, vicar, or perpetual curate may grant to the minister and churchwardens, or to the minister, churchwardens, and overseers of his parish.
