



# Companies Clauses Consolidation Act 1845

1845 CHAPTER 16 8 and 9 Vict

*Recovery of Damages and Penalties*

**156 Transient offenders.**

It shall be lawful for any officer or agent of the company<sup>F1</sup>...to seize and detain any person who shall have committed any offence against the provisions of this or the special Act, or any Act incorporated therewith, and whose name and residence shall be unknown to such officer or agent, and convey him, with all convenient despatch, before some justice, without any warrant or other authority than this or the special Act; and such justice shall proceed with all convenient despatch to the hearing and determining of the complaint against such offender.
