General meetings

79 Votes of lunatics and minors, &c.

If any shareholder be a [^{F1}person of unsound mind] or idiot, such [^{F1}person of unsound mind] or idiot may vote by his committee; and if any shareholder be a minor he may vote by his guardian or any one of his guardians; and every such vote may be given either in person or by proxy.
