## *General meetings*

### **79** **Votes of lunatics and minors, &c.**

If any shareholder be a [<sup>F1</sup>person of unsound mind] or idiot, such [<sup>F1</sup>person of unsound mind] or idiot may vote by his committee; and if any shareholder be a minor he may vote by his guardian or any one of his guardians; and every such vote may be given either in person or by proxy.
