

# Bank Notes (Scotland) Act 1845

### **1845 CHAPTER 38 8 and 9 Vict**

## Penalty for persons, other than bankers hereby authorized, issuing notes payable on demand for less than 5*l*.

If any body politic or corporate or any person or persons shall make, sign, issue, or re-issue in Scotland any promissory note payable on demand to the bearer thereof for any sum of money less than the sum of five pounds, [FI] except banknotes issued in reliance on section 213 of the Banking Act 2009 ], then and in either of such cases every such body politic or corporate or person or persons so making, signing, issuing, or re-issuing any such promissory note as aforesaid, except as aforesaid, shall for every such note so made, signed, issued, or re-issued forfeit the sum of twenty pounds.
