CHAPTER 17

BURGH TRADING ACT 1846

- [1.] †After the passing of this Act exclusive privileges and rights in burghs to cease; and in lieu of the stamp duties now payable on admission a duty of 5s. shall be paid.
 - 2 Incorporations still to retain their corporate character, and their names and titles.
 - Incorporations may make bye laws relative to application of its funds, &c. subject to the approbation of the Court of Session. Such bye laws, when sanctioned by Court of Session, to be valid.
