1831 CHAPTER 32 1 and 2 Will 4

44 Appeal to quarter sessions.

Any person who shall think himself aggrieved by any summary conviction in pursuance of this Act may appeal to the justices at the next general or quarter sessions of the peace . . . ^{F1}
