CHAPTER 42

ALLOTMENTS ACT 1832

- Trustees and Parish Officers in Vestry assembled may let Portions of Poor Allotments to industrious Cottagers.
- II Land to be duly cultivated.
 - III Vestry to be held annually to receive Applications. Order of Vestry to authorize Occupation.
 - IV Payment of Rent.
 - V If Rent is in arrear, or Land not duly cultivated, Tenant may be evicted.
 - VI Power to recover Possession of Land illegally held aver, by summary Process.
 - VII Arrears of Rent how to be recovered.
 - VIII Application of Rent.
 - IX Power to exchange, for greater Convenience of Cottagers.
 - X No Habitations to be erected.
 - XI Extending Powers and Provisions of this Act to 1 & 2 W.4 c.42 and c.59.
