1833 CHAPTER 41 3 and 4 Will 4

5 No Matter to be heard unless in Presence of Four Members of the Committee.

.....^{F1} no report or recommendation shall be made to His Majesty unless a majority of the members of such Judicial Committee present at the hearing shall concur in such report or recommendation: Provided always, that nothing herein contained shall prevent His Majesty, if he shall think fit, from summoning any other of the members of his said Privy Council to attend the meetings of the said Committee.
