## **1835 CHAPTER 50**

## XXXII Persons may be excused by Justices from Payment of Highway Rate.

And be it further enacted, That it shall and may be lawful for the Justices at a Special Sessions for the Highways, on Application made to them by any Person rated to any Rate under the Authority of this Act to be discharged therefrom, on Proof of his Inability through Poverty to pay such Rate, the Surveyor having been first summoned to appear on the Part of the Parish, to order and direct that such Person shall be excused from the Payment of such Rate; and which Order of the said Justices is hereby declared to be final with respect to such Rate.
