1835 CHAPTER 62 5 and 6 Will 4

18 Voluntary declaration in the form in the schedule may be taken.

 \dots ^{F1} It shall and may be lawful for any justice of the peace, notary public, or other officer now by law authorized to administer an oath, to take and receive the declaration of any person voluntarily making the same before him in the form in the schedule to this Act annexed; \dots ^{F2}
