### The Railway and Canal Commission (Abolition) Act, 1949 (Commencement) Order, 1949

1949 No. 603

*Made - - - - - 29th March, 1949*

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 29th day of March, 1949

Present,

The King's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas by subsection (1) of section 7 of the Railway and Canal Commission (Abolition) Act, 1949(a), it is provided that that Act shall come into force on such day as His Majesty may by Order in Council appoint :

Now, therefore, His Majesty, in pursuance of the said provisions and in exercise of all other powers enabling Him in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows :—

1. The Railway and Canal Commission (Abolition) Act, 1949, shall come into force on the first day of April nineteen hundred and forty-nine.
2. This Order may be cited as the Railway and Canal Commission (Abolition) Act, 1949 (Commencement) Order, 1949.
