The Tithe Fees Rules 1951

1. In these Rules—
 - (a) “Commission” means the “Tithe Redemption Commission” and
 - (b) “corn rent annuity” means an annuity charged on land for the redemption of tithe rent charge or of a corn rent, rentcharge or money payment redeemed under the Tithe Acts, 1936 to 1936.
2. These Rules may be cited as The Tithe Fees Rules, 1951, and shall come into operation on the first day of September, 1951.
3. The fees set out in the Schedules to these Rules shall be payable for and in respect of the matters therein more particularly described.
